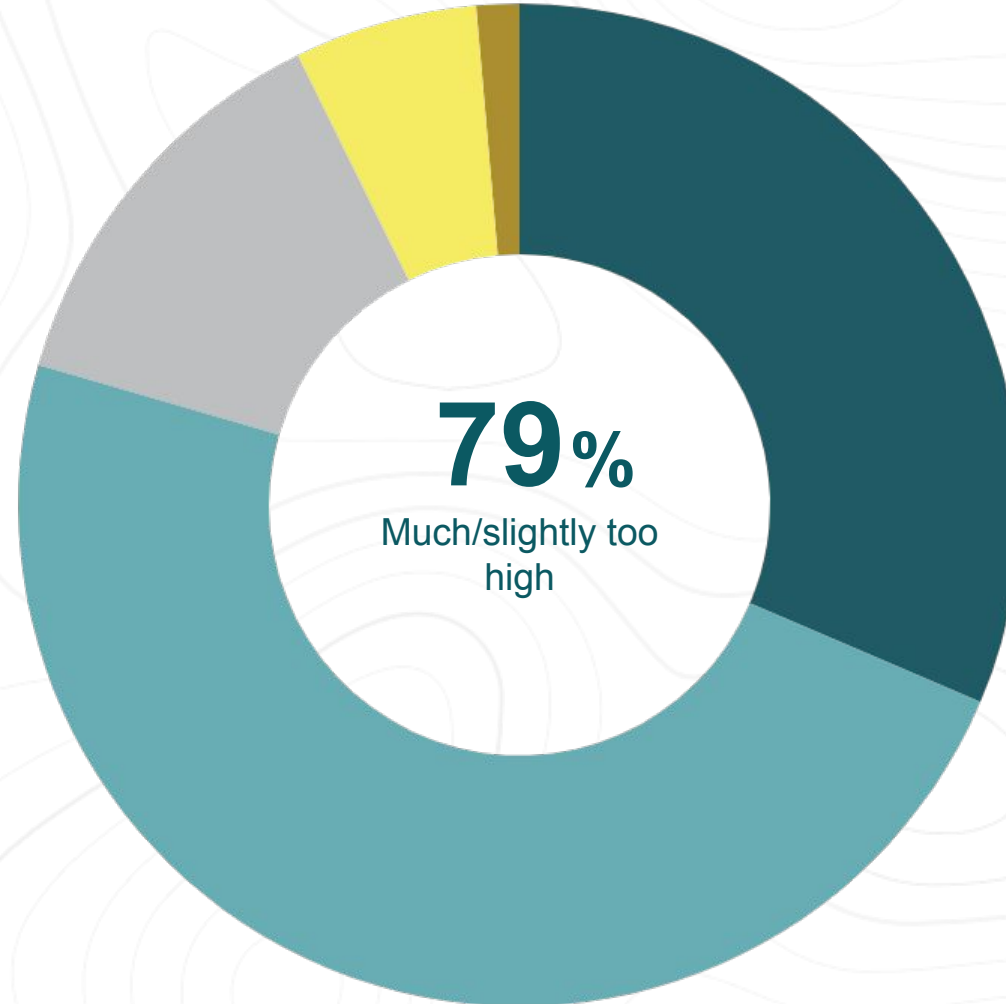

-  Neutral



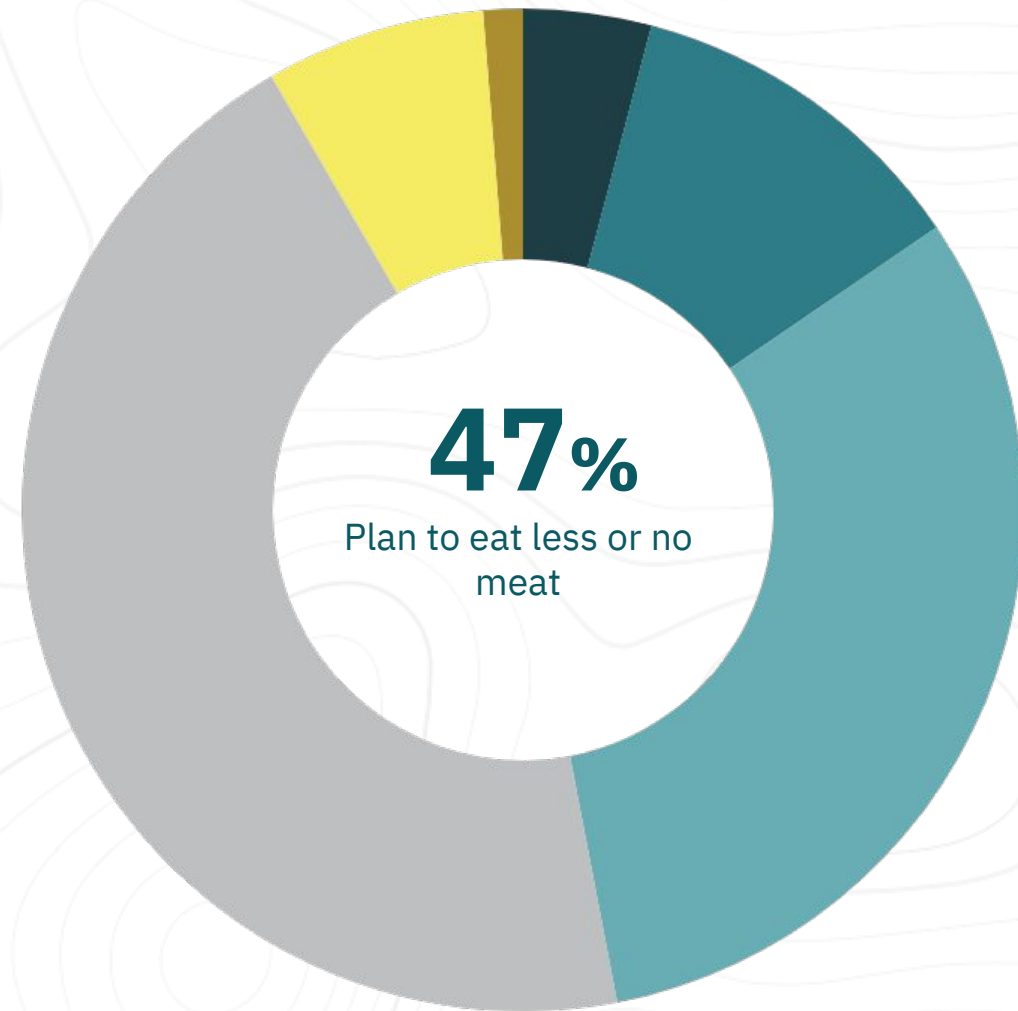

- About the same amount



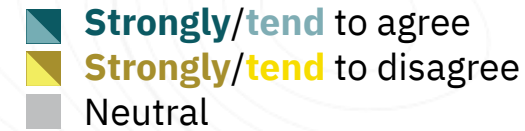

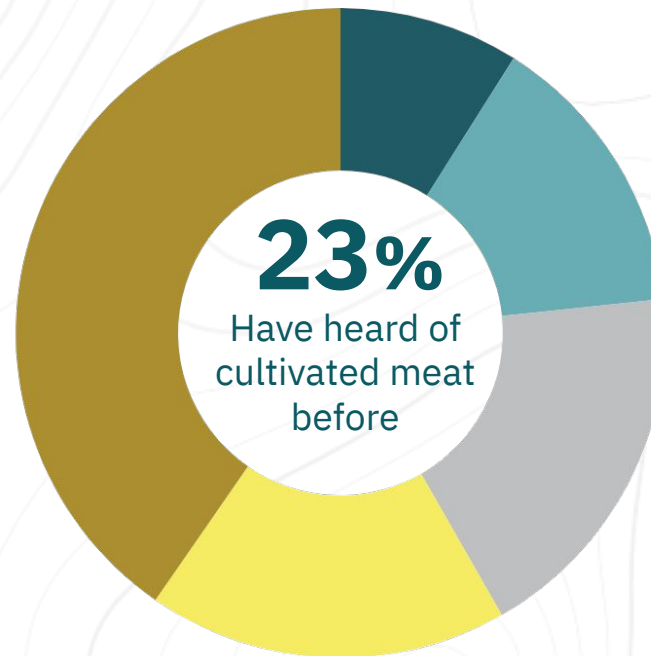

Awareness of cultivated meat

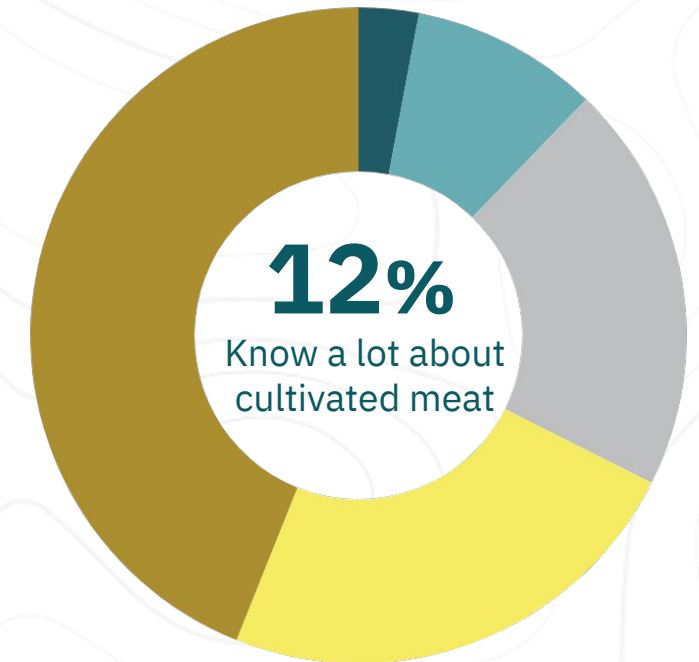


To what extent do you agree with the following statements?

“Cultivated meat is the same beef, pork and chicken that we eat today. However, it is not produced by raising and slaughtering animals. Instead, it involves taking a small sample of cells from an animal and placing them in a fermentor, which provides them with the water, nutrients and warmth they need to grow. The resulting meat can be made into a range of familiar foods, such as burgers and sausages.”

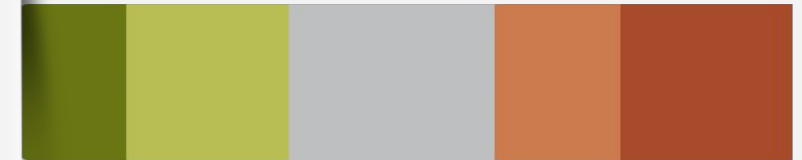

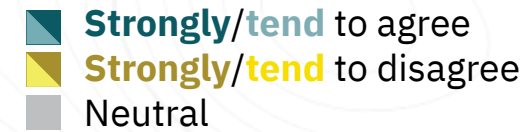

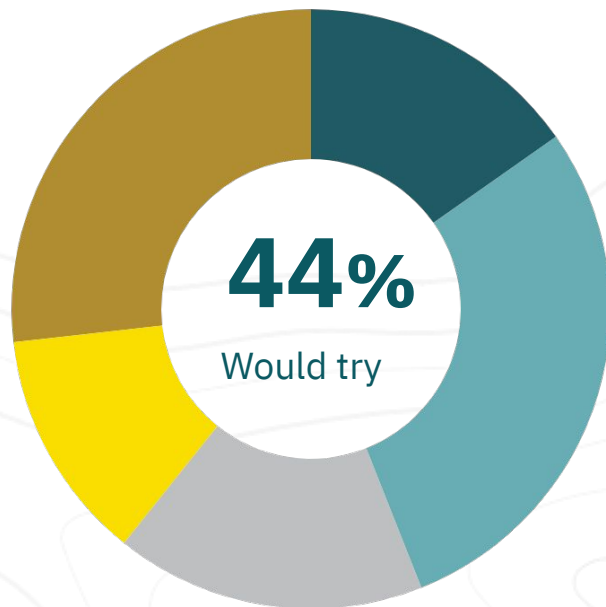

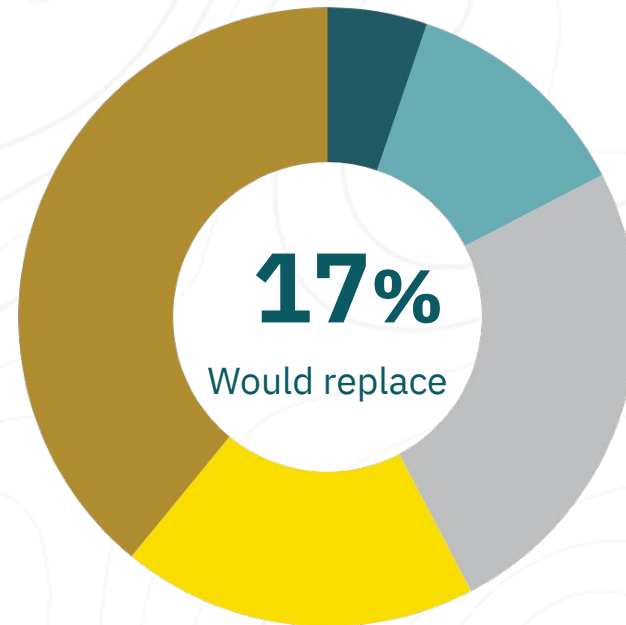
Openness to cultivated meat



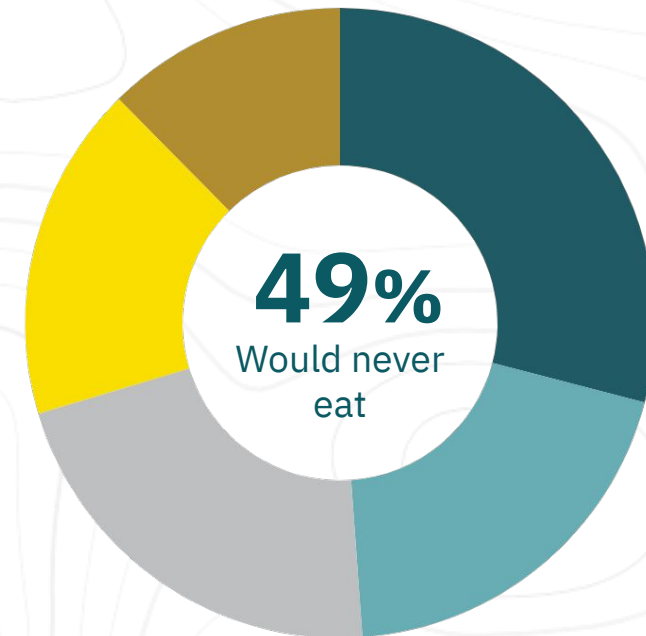
To what extent do you agree with the following statements?
